Entry forms without signatures and Agreement and Rules on the entry form will not be accepted. All overnight express mail entries must have the acceptance signature waived. Confirmation of entry and judging program will be sent by e-mail to the address printed on the entry form, or if no e-mail address is provided, sent via first class mail to the address listed on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. All overnight express mail entries must have the acceptance signature waived.

Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations MUST be received in writing or via e-mail prior to the closing of entries, be legible, and include the AKC number of dog, or no refunds will be issued. No verbal changes accepted.

REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season on the day of the trial are not permitted to compete. Entry fees for bitches in season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (minus \$10.00 per day administration fee) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on February 4, 2012.

No refunds for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES

Confirmation of entry and judging program will be sent by e-mail to the address printed on the entry form, or if no e-mail address is provided, will be sent (via First Class USPS mail) to the address on the Official AKC entry form, as soon as possible after the closing date as per AKC Rules and Regulations. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

An entry for a dog for more than one day MUST be identical. If a dog is to be entered in different classes each day, use a separate entry form for each day.

Owners are responsible for completing entry forms correctly. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

The Show Committee and Show Secretary will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these trials.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates, except when competing.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the table steward well ahead of time, and by being present with your dog when your turn comes. Every effort will be made to accommodate conflicts, but no guarantees can be made if a handler/dog is not ready for their scheduled run. Please politely report any conflicts to the gate steward as soon as possible.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Dogs should be able to perform all exercises safely.

If, according to the owner's records the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of this trial, it may be moved up to the next class provided that a request for a move-up is presented in writing to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit (according to Chapter 1, Section 16 of AKC Obedience Regulations, 1/1/2005).

SITE INFORMATION

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and pens. Please pick up after your dogs on the trial grounds. *Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial, with no entry fees refunded.*

CRATING:

X-pens are not allowed indoors. Crates may be left overnight, however neither TROCCW, Camp Bandy nor the Trial Secretary will be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the site. No dogs may be left unattended overnight.

FOOD:

Food and beverages for lunch will be available for sale on site. Exhibitors who volunteer to help with the trials will be provided FREE lunch. Fast food restaurants are available in Stevens Point and Waupaca about 20 minutes drive to the west or east.

LODGING:

The following hotels are available in the area. Most welcome well-behaved people and their pets; however, exhibitors must contact hotels directly and identify themselves as having dogs. Be sure to verify the dog policy with the hotel of your choice when you make your reservation. Please be a responsible owner and a considerate hotel guest by maintaining a quiet atmosphere and cleaning up after your dog.

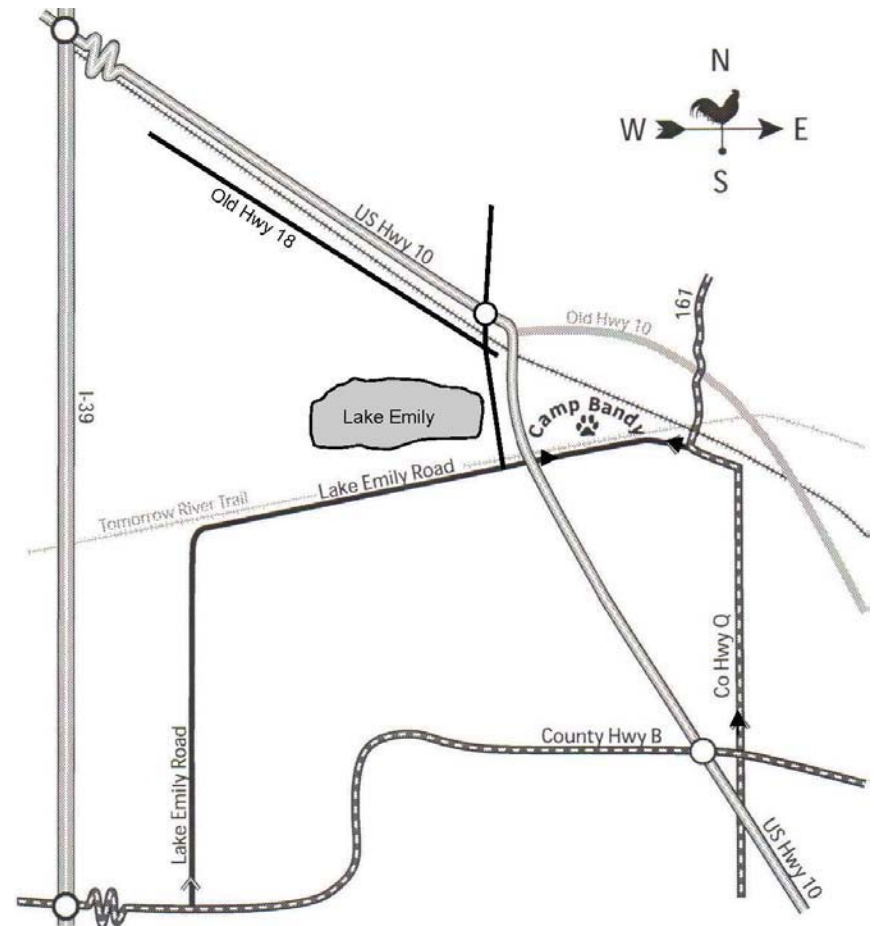

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Dogs entering mixed breed classes (eligible only in standalone Agility, Obedience and Rally trials) should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants. AKC Canine Partners listing number must be included on the entry form and AKC* NO. must be checked.
