Classes will fill, you must be pre-registered to attend class. All class handouts will be delivered by email. Six weeks - \$100.00



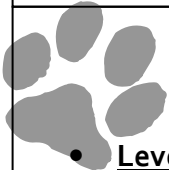

Within the first weeks most student's dogs will be ignoring distractions (even food) in favor of strong focus and motivation for the target odor of birch. Nosework is fun for enrichment, thoughtful activity or competition.

Directions: Take Hwy 10, 10 miles east of Stevens Point, 12 miles west of Waupaca, Exit County Hwy B west, turn east toward Amherst. Turn left, north on Q. Follow Q into Amherst Junction; at post office go straight when Q goes right. Camp Bandy is on the right approximately four blocks out of town.
